2003 Renter instructions for using Form CRP

Purpose of CRP

Qualified renters may apply for a refund based on property taxes paid on their principal place of residence. For purposes of the property tax refund, 19 percent of the rent you paid during the year is considered the portion paid for property tax.

Your landlord is required to give you a completed "Certificate of Rent Paid", Form CRP, no later than January 31, 2004. You will need this CRP if you apply for a property tax refund.

If you lived with a roommate, your landlord is required to give each of you a separate CRP showing that each of you paid an equal portion of the rent, regardless of the portion you actually paid or whose names are on the lease.

Eligibility requirements

To qualify for the property tax refund:

- you must have been a full or part-year resident of Minnesota during 2003,
- you could not be claimed as a dependent on someone else's 2003 federal income tax return,
- you must have lived in a building on which the owner was assessed property taxes or made payments in lieu of property taxes, and
- your total household income must have been less than \$44,990.

Household income is your federal adjusted gross income plus most nontaxable income. If you are married and living together, the incomes of both spouses are included in household income. If you are single, use your income only; do not include the income of any other person living with you.

To arrive at your total household income, a subtraction is allowed if you have dependents or if you or your spouse are age 65 or older or disabled.

If you are eligible for the property tax refund, apply by filing Form M1PR, "Property Tax Refund Return." You must include this CRP when you file your return.
